Programs

Second Greenlight for Girls Day Cincinnati Sponsored by P&G and hosted at University of Cincinnati (UC). Volunteer support from a variety of community partners who are passionate to support Girls in STEM.

GCSC Summer STEM Camps Developed and funded by GCSC. Hosted and led by partners across the region; K-12 teachers as well as community organizations such as Cincinnati Recreation Centers, YMCA's, Boys & Girls Clubs, and libraries.

Summer STEM / Design Fest for students and families (or similar program designed to support parents to play *the starring role* to support their student(s) in STEM.

Individual summer STEM programs run by GCSC partners NKU CINSAM, UC colleges, iSPACE, Girl Scouts, Cincinnati Observatory, Rosie's Girls, and many more.
